



VACCINATION POLICY

Our community's safety is of utmost importance during this unprecedented pandemic. In accordance with guidance from the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health and the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, AMA has implemented the following public health guidelines, physical distancing, hygiene, and cleaning practices:

- Face coverings worn by all staff and students indoors and outdoors
- Physical, social distancing by all staff and students
- COVID-19 Screening procedures
 - Using Titan HST by all staff and students upon entry onto campus
 - Using paper-based questionnaires for visitors
- Staying/sending home when sick
 - Implementing the LAUSD COVID-19 Containment, Response, and Control Plan
- Restroom availability for hand-washing and abundant hand sanitizer availability when hand washing is not feasible
- School-approved Environmental Protection Agency-listed disinfectant products proven to eliminate the COVID-19 virus

In addition to implementing these COVID-19 preventative and exposure management practices and procedures, AMA has implemented the following COVID-19 vaccination policy:

- Conduct a school-wide COVID-19 Awareness Trainings
 - 8/30/21 – Staff Professional Development in preparation for Student Training
 - 9/13/21-9/17/21 – Daily Student Training during Advisory Classes
 - Prior Knowledge
 - Preventative Practices
 - Vaccine Education
- Staff Vaccination
 - 9/6/21 – Documentation and Tracking of Staff Vaccination
 - 1/10/21 – All AMA Staff Fully Vaccinated
- Scholar and Community Vaccination
 - 9/17/21 – Documentation and Tracking of Student Vaccination
 - 1/8/21 – Vaccine Education Materials Distributed during COVID-19 testing
 - 1/10/21 – AMA Community Vaccination Education begins
